Victorian International Container Terminal - COVID-19 Closure

Dear Valued Customer,

C.H. Robinson have received advise from the Victorian International Container Terminal (VICT) that they have experienced a COVID-19 positive case and are currently working with the Victorian Government of Health and Human Services (DHHS) to determine the close contacts.

VICT have advised of an immediate closure for landside operations for a deep cleaning exercise and anticipate a re-opening from 10pm on September 20, subject to DHHS advice.

As a result, we expect delays to occur as VICT work to restore the effective movement of containers through the terminal adding additional pressure on transport carriers and their ability to maintain delivery schedules. C.H. Robinson will work closely with those customers impacted by the closure and forthcoming delays.

Our teams will continue to monitor the situation, provide updates, and manage through the associated challenges to the best of our ability, minimising the impact to your supply chain.
