Due to the inclement weather and strong winds brought by Typhoon Kompasu, Yantian International Container Terminal (YICT) in Shenzhen, Guangdong province, as well as Hong Kong port, ceased container handling operations after the Chinese weather authorities issued a yellow alert earlier today. Flight and ground operations have been suspended at Hong Kong Airport Terminals.
