Update to Texas-Mexico Border Delays

Dear Valued Customer,

We would like to provide an update to the Client Advisory we communicated on April 12, 2022.

As of the morning of Wednesday, April 13, freight traffic appears to be flowing slowly, but regularly across the U.S. and Mexico border.

- Protest related disruption decreased Tuesday evening but has been sporadic on Wednesday morning
- The Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS) continues to conduct secondary inspections causing congestion
- As we approach the Easter holiday, the US Customs hours of operations vary and can be found here: Locate a Port of Entry | U.S. Customs and Border Protection (cbp.gov)

Conditions are changing quickly, and we expect disruptions and slowdowns to continue. We are closely monitoring the situation and will update accordingly.
