Idling of the Union Pacific Global 3 Intermodal Ramp in Rochelle, IL

Dear Valued Customer,

The Union Pacific (UP) rail has announced they will be idling the Global 3 (G3) Intermodal Ramp in Rochelle, IL in the first half of July 2019. In parallel, the Global 2 facility will cease international intermodal service in order to focus on domestic intermodal freight.

At the end of July 2019, the majority of the UP international intermodal containers will be handled at the Global 4 ramp in Joliet, IL. The rail has committed to making adjustment and investing in Global 4 as to ensure it will be capable of accommodating the additional capacity. While the purpose of these changes is to create efficiencies within the UP rail network, we will keep monitoring the transition of operations and tracking to identify any delay in the process.
