## Flooding in Midwestern U.S. Affecting Intermodal Service (May 2019)

Dear Valued Customer,

The Midwest region is experiencing flooding again, which is impacting the railroad network in Kansas, Missouri, Oklahoma and Arkansas. This storm system has also produced heavy snow in Wyoming and Colorado causing challenges in the Denver, CO area.

Service disruptions include delays in transit, closed track sections, as well as gate closures in some locations. Shipments moving through the affected areas may experience delays.

Severe weather is forecasted to continue through the Memorial Day holiday weekend. The rail companies have positioned resources, so crews can react quickly to any additional service interruptions. They will also work at re-routing some trains to minimize the disruption to traffic flows as much as possible.
