China Tariffs to Remain at 25%, No Additional Products to be Added

Dear valued customer.

As reported by the news outlets, President Trump commented on his meeting with President Xi Jinping of China during a press conference June 29, 2019 at the G20 Summit in Osaka, Japan.

President Trump made several comments that "(We) Had a very, very good meeting with China." and "The negotiations are continuing." President Trump has agreed to leave the current tariffs in place and to not add any additional products to the list that carry the safeguard tariffs for now. China has agreed to buy American food and agricultural products while negotiations continue.

The Office of the U.S. Trade Representative (USTR) has created a web page to assist the trade in searching and confirming if their HTS number is affected: https://ustr.gov/issue-areas/enforcement/section-301-investigations/search. To search a commodity, enter the HTS number to the 8-digit level, without punctuation; e.g.: 84199030. Search results will then be provided.
