

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Section 301 Product Exclusions Announced

Dear Valued Customer,

The Office of the United States Trade Representative (USTR) announced additional rounds of product exclusions on goods from China that fall under the Section 301 tariffs - tranche 1.

Exemptions will apply retroactively to July 6, 2018 and will be valid for one year after the USTR publishes notice in the Federal Register. Importers may file a post-summary correction (PSC) or a protest to obtain a refund.

Below are links to all six rounds of Section 301 product exclusions, including the coordinating Cargo Systems Messaging Service (CSMS) ID Number that identifies CBP instructions for filing the exemptions.
