CBP Increases User Fees Effective October 1, 2019

Dear Valued Customer,

U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) announced recently an adjustment to certain customs user fees and corresponding limitation established by the Consolidated Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act (COBRA) for Fiscal Year 2020. The entire list of fee changes is listed [here](#). On August 9th, CBP issued [CSMS #39291492](#) notifying the trade of this change.

Importers may be most affected by certain fees from Table 2:

Merchandise Processing Fee

Minimum increase from \$26.22 to \$26.79

Maximum increase from \$508.70 to \$519.76

Informal Entry or Release

Increase from \$2.10 to \$2.14
