
Mexico Protests

Dear Valued Customer,

Please be informed the continued protests in Mexico had been affecting port operations and the flow of goods on different regions around the country and across all modes.

The protesting started on August 8, 2019 and is expected to continue for the immediate future. To date, there has been blockage of major highways and rail (Distritos de Toluca, Caltzontzin y Acambaro), also total closure for Manzanillo & Altamira ports. There have been a number of delays on shipments, which are continued to be expected as protesting continues.

There has been no official communication from Mexican authority at this point, but from our knowledge these are the main points being affected:
