Port of Dalian in the Liaoning Province temporarily closed due to Typhoon Lekima

Dear Valued Customer,

On August 10, 2019, Port of Dalian was impacted by typhoon Lekima. Due to the inclement weather and strong winds, the Port of Dalian has been shut down since the evening of August 10, 2019. All operations are currently paused. The port is planning to partially reopen for inbound containers on the evening of August 13, 2019. The partial reopen is weather dependent.

Feeder vessels departing from Port of Dalian are being delayed, which may cause the vessel to miss connections. In the weeks to come, Port of Dalian will most likely experience extended delays due to the impacts of typhoon Lekima.

At this point international flights have not been affected at Dalian airport, and there have been no additional cancellations due to the typhoon.
