Section 301 Tariffs Increase

Dear Valued Customer,

In a tweet posted Friday afternoon, President Trump has announced that the duty rate for Section 301 List 1, List 2, and List 3 goods would increase from 25% to 30% effective October 1, 2019.

In addition, the duty rate for List 4 products that are due to go into effect September 1, 2019 would be 15%, instead of the anticipated 10%. No mention was made about the tariffs on List 4 products that are set to increase on December 15, 2019.

The increases are a response to China's retaliation of raising of their duty rates on U.S. goods.
