Section 301 Tariffs on European Union Products

Dear Valued Customer,

On October 18, 2019, the United States will impose additional tariffs on more than 150 goods imported from the European Union in response to the World Trade Organization decision in the Airbus subsidy case.

The U.S. will impose a 10% tariff on new aircraft from France, Germany, Spain and the United Kingdom. Additionally, the U.S. will also impose a 25% tariff on specific goods imported from numerous European countries including whiskey, wine, and dairy from specific countries.
