Chile Protests

Please be informed that Santiago and six other cities in Chile have been affected by protests. The situation has affected port and airport operations in different regions around the country and is impacting operations across all modes of transportation.

The protesting started on October 14, 2019 and is being caused by rising fares in public transportation and overall rise in cost of living. Large crowds of protesters continue to gather and have expressed violent demonstrations until today. Despite the government's withdraw on the increase in public transportation fares, the disruptions and violence remain. Chile's President, Sebastian Piñera, declared a State of Emergency on Friday evening, October 18, 2019.
