Section 301 Tariffs – Extension Requests for List 1 Exclusions

Dear Valued Customer,

The Office of the U.S. Trade Representative (USTR) has announced that they will consider extending List 1 product exclusions that were granted in December 2018 for up to twelve additional months.

On November 1, 2019 at noon EDT the USTR will begin accepting public comment on specific List 1 product exclusions. Comments must be submitted by November 30, 2019 and will need to be made through the <u>Federal</u> <u>eRulemaking Portal</u>, referencing docket number USTR-2019-0019.
