United States – Mexico – Canada Agreement to Move Forward

Dear Valued Customer,

The United States – Mexico – Canada Agreement (USMCA) is a renegotiation of the North American Free Trade Agreement (NAFTA). It has been signed by the member countries but has not been ratified. Negotiations have been ongoing since its formal acceptance November 1, 2018.

On Tuesday, December 10, 2019, it was announced that House Democrats have agreed to move forward on the trade agreement. The USMCA still has to be voted on in the House of Representatives and Senate and signed by President Trump.
