UPDATE - Houston container port terminals set to re-open

Dear Valued U.S. Customer,

Please be advised that the Port Authority has conducted a thorough investigation regarding the ILA worker, who recently worked at both Bayport and Barbours Cut terminals, who tested positive for coronavirus (COVID-19). The ILA worker is currently in quarantine at a hospital.

Port Houston has conducted a joint investigation with the ILA which indicated that his exposure to others was fairly limited. Following CDC guidelines, anyone who was in direct contact with this worker during the 2 days worked at Port Houston facilities are in self-quarantine. Additionally, those who maintained social distancing from the worker, and have low risk, have been advised.

The port has taken prudent steps to ensure they resume operations responsibly and safely.

Beginning tonight March 19, 2020 at 19:00, both Bayport and Barbours Cut Terminals will be reopened for vessel operations only.

The port will reopen both container terminals for regular business tomorrow morning, March 20, 2020.

Port Houston is continuing to monitor the situation and will provide updates as warranted if this situation changes.
