Section 301 Safeguard Tariff Request for Comments

Dear Valued U.S. Import Customer,

The Office of the U.S. Trade Representative (USTR) is requesting comments on extension of product exclusions due to expire June 4, 2020. The USTR issued 89 product exclusions from List 1 commodities on June 4, 2019. If approved, exclusions would be extended for a 1-year period.

All comments must be submitted via the online portal: <https://comments.USTR.gov> under Public Docket No. USTR-2020-0013. The portal will open April 1, 2020 and will close April 30, 2020. Please ensure you have the Exclusion Number and Product Description available.

Medical Supply Comments Requested

Recently the USTR approved certain medical supplies for exclusion due to the COVID-19 outbreak. They have issued a pre-publication notice on requesting comments for product exclusions on additional medical care commodities.

When opened on the online portal, comments are to be submitted electronically under Public Docket No. USTR-2020-0014 prior to June 25, 2020; and may be extended to a later date. Responses to comments should be submitted within three (3) business days after the comment is posted.
