Container Imbalance Surcharge (CIS) U.S. LCL Advisory Postponement

Dear Valued Customer,

The ocean carriers have announced the postponement of the Container Imbalance Surcharge (CIS) on LCL export to the below mentioned trade lanes. The effective CIS will be applied to all cargo received on board vessels sailing on or after April 20, 2020.

This is a direct result of the ocean carrier's blank sailing strategy which is triggered by the low/no volumes on TPEB. Based on ocean carrier comments and industry media, it is expected that this trend will continue.

C.H. Robinson will continue to evaluate the market to ensure each customer receives the most competitive offering in the marketplace. These levels are pre-filed rates consistent with the ocean carriers to ensure FMC (U.S. Federal Maritime Commission) compliance. We will continue to monitor the market and levels to ensure our rates remain competitive.
