Please be advised that we are closely following the developments of Cyclone Amphan and its impact on the coast of East India and Bangladesh. Currently, all our staff, including that of our agent Seagold in Bangladesh, have reported safe. Flooding and infrastructural damage has been reported in many coastal areas in West Bengal, including that of the airport of Kolkata. Cargo movements are expected to face some disruptions as the region tries to recover.
