Section 301 Exclusion – New Updates

The Office of the United States Trade Representative (USTR) and the U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) has issued relevant announcements related to the Section 301 duties and exclusions.

New Exclusions and Technical Amendments Announced

- July 15, 2020 Technical amendments and guidance published for List 3 exclusions.
 - o CSMS #43464503 and Federal Register Notice 85 FR 42968
- July 17, 2020 Additional product exclusions and technical amendments to List 4.

- July 17, 2020 Guidance published for List 1 6th tranche of product exclusions extended to December 31, 2020 (previous exclusion number 9903.88.11; now 9903.88.52).

Hong Kong Normalization Executive Order Will Not Increase Tariffs

As reported by *International Trade Today* on July 23, 2020, an email from a senior administration official, the Executive Order will not increase tariffs on goods of Hong Kong origin. "The July 14, 2020, Executive Order on Hong Kong Normalization does not provide for new U.S. tariffs on goods from Hong Kong," the official said. "The Administration will continue to evaluate and adjust our policies as conditions warrant." Please see to C.H. Section 301 Exclusions Expiring Soon
