Merchandise Processing Fee to Increase October 1, 2020

Dear Valued U.S. Import Customer,

U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) has announced that certain fees, including the Merchandise Processing Fee (MPF), will increase again on October 1, 2020, per the Consolidated Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act (COBRA) of 1985. MPF was previously increased on October 1, 2019.

The minimum MPF fee for formal entries will increase to \$27.23 from \$26.22, and the maximum fee will increase to \$528.33 from \$519.76. The ad valorem rate of 0.3464% will remain the same.
