Section 301 Exclusion – New Updates

Dear Valued U.S. Import Customer,

The Office of the United States Trade Representative (USTR) and the U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) has issued relevant announcements related to the Section 301 duties and exclusions.

New Product Exclusions Announced for List 4

On August 6, 2020, USTR issued a new round of product exclusions for List 4 that will be retroactively applied to September 1, 2019 and will expire on September 1, 2020. Products excluded include plastic locking zip ties, slingshot apparatus, and swing sets and parts thereof. A full list of excluded products can be found <u>here</u>.

Some Section 301 Exclusions Extended to December 31, Others Expired August 7, 2020

USTR announced that only 266 exclusions originally permitted for list 3 will be extended through December 31, 2020, leaving the more than 700 exclusions to be expired. A list of the exclusions with harmonized tariff numbers that will not expire until December can be found <u>here</u>.
