United States to Impose 10% Tariffs on Canadian Aluminum Again

Dear Valued U.S. Import Customer,

On August 6, 2020, the White House announced that the United States will be imposing a 10% Section 232 tariff on non-alloyed unwrought aluminum articles effective August 16, 2020. Articles classified under HTSUS subheading 7601.10 will be subject to the additional 10% duties. All other aluminum products will remain exempt from the Section 232 tariff.

The proclamation advised that the 59% of aluminum imports from Canada between June 2019 and May 2020 fall into the non-alloyed unwrought aluminum category. A link to the full Presidential proclamation is below.

Canadian aluminum had been previously subject to the Section 232 tariffs that the Trump administration had imposed in 2018, but had been removed from the list of countries in 2019 after an agreement was made between the two countries.
