Rulemaking Proposed to End Section 301 Tariffs on De Minimis Goods

Dear Valued U.S. Import Customer,

US Customs and Border Protection (CBP) has submitted a proposed rule to eliminate Section 301 tariffs on goods that are valued \$800.00 or less, according to the Office of Management and Budget (OMB). The proposed rule “Excepting Merchandise Subject to Section 301 Duties from the Customs De Minimis Exemption” can be found on OMB’s site [here](#).

OMB must review the proposed rulemaking before it can be published, and the review can take 90 – 120 days. This change will likely impact eCommerce goods and other low value shipments.
