Section 301 Exclusion – New Updates

Dear Valued U.S. Import Customer,

The Office of the United States Trade Representative (USTR) and the U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) has issued relevant announcements related to the Section 301 duties and exclusions.

List 1 and 2 Tariff Exclusion Extensions and Expirations as of September 20, 2020

More than 300 exclusions will expire on September 20, 2020 as USTR declined to extend them. In two separate notices (links below) USTR identifies 62 HTS numbers that will be extended for List 1 and 17 exclusions for List 2. These exclusions will be extended through December 31, 2020.
