Port Congestion Surcharge U.S./Canada to Sydney, Australia

Dear Valued Customer,

The ocean carriers that provide service from the United States and Canada to Sydney, Australia have announced and filed a Port Congestion Surcharge (PCS) to the levels noted below. This surcharge is due to a combination of factors including industrial action and the carriers are experiencing heavy congestion at Sydney, Australia terminals. The effective PCS will be applied to all containers in-gated at the origin receiving terminal on or after October 29, 2020

C.H. Robinson will continue to evaluate the market to ensure each customer receives the most competitive offering in the marketplace. These levels are pre-filed rates consistent with the ocean carriers to ensure FMC (U.S. Federal Maritime Commission) compliance. We will continue to monitor the market and levels to ensure our rates remain competitive.
