DALIAN PORT CLOSURE

Dear Valued Customers.

Please be advised that Dalian main port, has advised that both inbound and outbound terminals in Dayao Bay, have been closed since Dec. 21st 2020, as there has been a few confirmed cases of COVID-19. All vessel, yard, and gate operations have been stopped until further notice. Hence, delays are expected for the following weeks.

Additionally, due to port closure, a large number of containers cannot be discharged, resulting in a serious shortage of empty equipment turnover this week. On the other hand, air import and export operations have not been affected at present.

C.H. Robinson Freight Services (China) Ltd. Dalian Branch remains normal operations and our staff are safe. We are reaching out to ocean carriers to find out their contingency plans, and we are keeping in close contact with the port of Dalian to gather more information as to their next steps. We will provide further updates as they become available.
