Port of Tauranga, Rail Delays

Dear Valued Customer,

C.H. Robinson wish to advise of delays connecting by rail for import containers from discharge at the Port of Tauranga to Auckland Metroport. Currently for non-managed containers, it is taking 4 weeks and with shuttle selected (managed) containers anywhere between 7-10 days.

We advise customers who have urgent freight, to contact their customer services representative. Arrangements can be made by way of termination of the container in Tauranga and a dedicated truck sent to collect the container for arrival in Auckland. This will incur additional charges in application to terminate, added cartage charges from Tauranga and empty return fees.

Our teams will continue to monitor the situation, provide updates, and manage through the associated challenges to the best of our ability, minimising the impact to your supply chain
