"CBP has broad authority to protect federally registered trademarks and copyrights at the border by preventing the entry of infringing imports into U.S. commerce, provided these IP rights are recorded through the e-Recordation program (visit <u>https://iprr.cbp.gov</u>) for more information). CBP enforces all recordations, no matter how large or small the enterprise of the IP owner."

- How to educate CBP on your products
- How to give in-person trainings on your product at the ports
- How to report violations
