Patrick Terminal Port Strikes, Australia

Dear Valued Customer,

C.H. Robinson has received notification from Patrick Terminals in relation to additional Protected Industrial Action (PIA) by the Maritime Union of Australia (MUA) and the current delays being experienced at their terminals.

Patrick Sydney AutoStrad terminal will incur extended industrial action throughout the month of June.

Patrick Terminals - Sydney AutoStrad

- Sydney terminal delays are now approximately 4 days.
- Some vessels are experiencing longer delays and with ongoing industrial action, delays for vessels arriving at the terminal are expected to increase.
- Two vessels have already been sub-contracted and further opportunities are being explored for subcontracting of vessels.

Patrick Terminals - Brisbane AutoStrad

- Terminal operations are now as normal.

Patrick Terminals - Fremantle

- Fremantle terminal delays remain at approximately 2 days.

- A ban on the performance of upgrades and/or work in higher levels at Port Botany (Sydney) commencing at 10pm Friday 4 June 2021 until 10pm Sunday 6 June 2021.
- A ban on the performance of upgrades and/or work in higher levels at Port Botany (Sydney) commencing at 10pm Friday 11 June 2021 until 10pm Sunday 13 June 2021.
- A ban on the performance of overtime commencing at 6am Thursday 17 June 2021 for a 14-day period finishing at 6am on Thursday 1 July 2021
- A ban on the performance of shift extensions commencing at 6am Thursday 17 June 2021 for a 14-day period finishing at 6am on Thursday 1 July 2021.

Patrick Terminals - Brisbane AutoStrad

- Work stoppages for 1-hour duration at 03.30, 11.30 and 19.30 on Tuesday 15 June 2021, Wednesday 16 June 2021 and Thursday 17 June 2021.

Patrick Terminals - Fremantle

- A ban on attending for work on days an employee is rostered as “off/avail” commencing from 7.00am Friday 11 June 2021 and ending at 7.00am on Wednesday 30 June 2021.

Patrick Terminals - Melbourne

- The Maritime Union of Australia notified eight 12 hour stoppages at Webb Dock, starting on Friday 11 June 2021 and continuing every day from 6pm until 18 June 2021 as part of enterprise bargaining with automated stevedore Victorian International Container Terminals.

Our teams will continue to monitor the situation, provide updates, and manage through the associated challenges to the best of our ability, minimising the impact to your supply chain.
