### COVID-19 Impact on Shanghai Airport

Dear Valued Customer,

This is a follow up to our Client Advisory on August 20, 2020.

Over the weekend additional positive cases of COVID-19 were found at Shanghai Pudong (PVG) airport. The airport remains open, but significant cancellations of freighter flights continue until further notice.

There has been no formal announcement made by the airport, terminals, or ground handlers. Though the duration of these flight cancellations is still to be determined, the impact will be significant. Shanghai Pudong is the largest cargo airport in China and C.H. Robinson will continue to seek alternative routings to maintain our customer's supply chains.
