Aluminium Import License Requirements Delayed

Dear Valued Customer,

The Aluminium Import Monitoring and Analysis System (AIM) final rule has been delayed again according to the announcement made on the U.S. Department of Commerce's (Commerce) website. No new effective date had been announced. AIM reporting was supposed to go into effect on March 29, 2021 as it had been previously delayed in January by President Biden's administration as a regulatory freeze review being conducted by his administration.
