COVID-19 Products Section 301 Exclusions Extended to November

Dear Valued Customer,

The Office of the United States Trade Representative (USTR) announced that Section 301 exclusions for goods used to treat COVID-19 from China will be extended for 45 days until November 14, 2021. The exclusions were originally set to expire on September 30, 2021, but the USTR announced that it needed additional time to review public comments.

COVID-19 related goods covered by the article descriptions fall under the following exclusion harmonized tariff schedule numbers: 9903.88.62, 9903.88.63, 9903.88.64 and 9903.88.65 will be extended.
