## Additional Section 232 Tariffs to be Applied to Certain Finished Steel and Aluminum Articles

Dear Valued U.S. Import Customer,

President Donald Trump issued a proclamation on January 24, 2020 announcing additional Section 232 tariffs on imports of finished steel and aluminum articles. The government will impose 25 percent tariffs on some finished steel products and 10 percent on some finished aluminum products effective February 8, 2020.

The additional tariffs are due to increased imports for some steel and aluminum products and because domestic capacity has not risen as much as expected. Some of the products to be subject to the additional tariffs include steel nails, tacks, corrugated nails, and aluminum wire and cables.

The additional steel tariffs will apply to goods from all countries except Argentina, Australia, Brazil, Canada, Mexico and South Korea. The additional aluminum tariffs affect goods from all countries except Argentina, Australia, Canada and Mexico.
