## China Halves Tariffs on U.S. \$75 Billion Worth of U.S. Goods

Dear Valued Customer,

On February 6, 2020, the China Ministry of Finance announced plans to further reduce their retaliatory tariffs imposed on thousands of U.S. goods. The following tariffs imposed September 1, 2019 on U.S. \$75 billion worth of goods will be halved, effective on February 14, 2020.

**Effective February 14, 2020 at 13:01pm (local time):**

- 916 items (270 items in section 1 and 646 items in section 2) originally at 10% will be reduced **to 5%**
- 801 items (64 items in section 3 and 737 items in section 4) originally at 5% will be reduced **to 2.5%**
