COVID-19 Update – Closure of Houston container port terminals

Dear Valued U.S. Customer,

Please be advised that Port Houston, The International Port of Texas, has advised that both Bayport and Barbours Cut Terminals are closed – effective immediately, as there has been a confirmed case of COVID-19. All vessel, yard, and gate operations have been stopped until further notice.

The port has said all decisions on vessel schedules, demurrage, and all others will be determined as soon as possible. Please check their website for further details.

We are reaching out to ocean carriers to find out their contingency plans, and we are keeping in close contact with the port of Houston to gather more information as to their next steps. We will provide further updates as they become available.
