## Extended Compliance Period Issued for Hong Kong Marking Rules

Dear Valued U.S. Import Customer,

On August 21, 2020, U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) issued [CSMS Message #43729326](#) announcing an extension of the compliance period for marking goods produced in Hong Kong as Chinese origin. The compliance period is now extended through November 9, 2020. The previous extension period was through September 25, 2020.
