Operational Delays at the Ports of Auckland - Fergusson Terminal.

Dear Valued Customer,

On Sunday, August 30, 2020, the Ports of Auckland confirmed the death of a staff member after a fatal injury while working on a ship at Fergusson Terminal.

As a result, work stopped immediately. Fergusson Terminal advised they plan to recommence terminal operations on Monday morning, August 31, 2020, albeit with slightly reduced hours. We understand operations will be less than optimal, and delays are expected to continue throughout the week.

There have been changes to vessel schedules. Here are the most recent updates:

- Constantinos P has been delayed and is still undergoing discharge.
- Hansa Offenburg is now calling Port of Tauranga. If you have any containers on this vessel, please amend your entries to reflect the updated port.
- Tianjin Bridge 141 is in port; however, containers have not been discharged. We anticipate that this will occur today or tomorrow.

We are working closely with the Ports of Auckland, our partner carriers and our customers to minimise disruption and will keep you informed of updates as they emerge.
