Section 301 Exclusion – New Updates

Dear Valued U.S. Import Customer,

The Office of the United States Trade Representative (USTR) and the U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) has issued relevant announcements related to the Section 301 duties and exclusions.

List 4 Tariff Exclusion Extensions and Expirations as of September 1, 2020

USTR announced that 87 exclusions were going to be extended on September 1, through December 31, 2020, leaving over 200 other exclusions expired.
