Update: Port Congestion Surcharge – Melbourne and Brisbane, Australia

Dear Valued Customer,

As advertised on October 2, 2020, MSC will be implementing a Port Congestion Surcharge to shipments into Brisbane and Melbourne. Based on this additional surcharge, we will be implementing a minimum of USD 13.50 or USD 13.50 w/m surcharge to Less than Container Load (LCL) cargo arriving or departing Melbourne and Brisbane using MSC's service, within the following timeframes:

Import from US	Cargo Possession October 29, 2020	MSC	Minimum USD 13.50 or USD 13.50 w/m
