## Updates from U.S. Customs and Border Protection and U.S. Fish and Wildlife Services

### **Generalized System of Preferences (GSP) Revocation of Benefits from Thailand, Correction**

### **Post Summary Correction (PSC) Revert Capability and Liquidation Timeframe Policy**

CBP has made changes to the Automated Commercial Environment (ACE) to notify PSC filers when CBP disagrees with the PSC submission and the entry reverts to its previous version. Prior to this change, the PSC filer was unaware that CBP reverted the entry and the reason code. Additionally, once a PSC is reviewed by CBP, it will be set for the weekly liquidation cycle, unless liquidation of the entry summary is extended or suspended. Once set for liquidation, the only method that an importer/broker may use to further amend the entry summary is to file a protest. For more information, please review [CSMS #44714702](#).

### **Section 232 Imports of Aluminum Articles from Canada**

On October 27, 2020 the President issued a Presidential Proclamation on Adjusting Imports of Aluminum into the United States, reinstating Canada's exclusion from additional 10 percent duties under Section 232 on certain non-alloyed unwrought aluminum articles. This is effective on imports entered for consumption, or withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after September 1, 2020 for imports of non-alloyed unwrought aluminum articles of Canada provided for in HTS subheading 7601.10. ### **U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service ACE Implementation Delayed**

On November 11, FWS announced delayed implementation of the FWS Message Set in the Automated Commercial Environment (ACE). FWS is still in the process of formulating regulations requiring the utilization of ACE to submit import data for the FWS regulated commodities, and currently expects enforcement of mandatory submission in ACE to take effect in March 2021.
