## Patrick Terminals Closures

Dear Valued Customer,

As advised in the [DP World Terminal Closures](#) client advisory on November 17, 2020, we have received notice of stoppages at Patrick Terminals for the Annual General Meeting (AGM) of the Maritime Union Australia (MUA) on Tuesday, November 24, 2020 as per the following:

- Fremantle Terminal: 9:00am to 1:00pm
- Sydney Terminal: 6:00am to 2:00pm (first zone back 3:00pm) During this time the terminal will utilise the closure to perform a required shut down for the new rail project
- Melbourne Terminal, 9:30am to 1:30pm
- Brisbane Terminal: 7:00am to 11:00am

Stoppages will be conducted for approximately 4 hours to allow yard employees to vote on a new enterprise agreement. Terminal stoppages for an AGM are a positive step for the industry as we await finalised workplace agreements and the easing of industrial action that is affecting many Australian importers and exporters.

We expect delays and congestion to occur at Patrick Terminals as a result and increased lead times should be expected in the coming weeks. Our teams will continue to monitor the situation, provide updates, and manage through this challenge to the best of our ability, minimising the impact to your supply chain.
