Trans-Tasman Air Freight Peak Season

Dear Valued Customer,

The air freight market conditions on the Trans-Tasman trade from Melbourne and Sydney, Australia to Auckland, New Zealand has worsened as a result of heavy congestion and a delayed Ocean export market. As advised in the [New Zealand Market Update](#) on November 9, 2020, Ports of Auckland (POAL) remain heavily congested due to the number of vessels calling the port, container volumes, labour availability, and the suspension of berth windows.

As a result, we are seeing a high conversion of Ocean to Air cargo hitting the air freight market creating a significant surge in rates. We will endeavor to continue to provide competitive pricing solutions and appreciate your patience and understanding during these challenging times.
