Section 301 Exclusions Expiring Soon

Dear Valued U.S. Import Customer,

More than 550 Section 301 exclusions from all four lists will expire at the end of December unless the Office of the U.S. Trade Representative (USTR) announces an extension for those products. There are 19 exclusions from list 1 that will remain in effect until March and April 2021. Infographic below provides a breakdown of the number of exclusions that will expire on each list.

Section 301 List	December 27	December 31
List 1 – 25% Duty	6	125
List 2 – 25% Duty	0	63
List 3 – 25% Duty	0	266
List 4A – 7.5% Duty	0	108
