Import Entry Transaction Fee, New Zealand

Dear Valued Customer,

C.H. Robinson have been advised of changes to the New Zealand Import Entry Transaction Fees as of July 1, 2021.

The updated fees will be fairer to importers and exporters and better reflect the costs of clearing goods. The fees will cover more activities related to managing risk to New Zealand from imports and exports and will now include goods-related investigations and the seizing of goods.

The fee changes are the result of Customs' review of Goods Clearance Fees, which Customs consulted on extensively in 2019. The update to the fee structure were originally intended to take effect in 2020 and were delayed for a year because of the COVID-19 pandemic. The customs Import Entry Transaction Fee when billed, is combined with the Ministry for Primary Industries (MPI) fee and therefore a combined total will be charged as per below:
