Union Pacific Global IV Temporary Eastbound Suspension from West Coast Marine Terminals

Dear Valued Customer,

Effective Sunday, July 18th, 2021 at 23:59 PST, Union Pacific will not be accepting eastbound shipments to Global IV in Joliet, IL (servicing Chicago market) from any marine terminals on the US West Coast (Pacific South West and Pacific North West). This measure, put into place for a period of up to 7 days, is implemented to reduce the backlog of containers at Global IV as well as improve rail car fluidity, however, short term delays are expected.

In this context, C.H. Robinson will keep working with their customers to find alternative and relevant transportation solutions.
