### Forced Labor Finding Issued on Disposable Gloves from MY

---

Dear Valued Customer,

On March 29, 2021, U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) issued a Federal Register Notice confirming a Finding was issued covering disposable gloves classified under the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States (HTSUS) subheadings 3926.20.1020, 4015.11.0150, 4015.19.0550, 4015.19.1010, 4015.19.1050, and 4015.19.5000, which are mined, produced or manufactured wholly or in part by Top Glove Corporation Bhd in Malaysia.

This Finding applies to any merchandise that is imported on or after March 29, 2021. It also applies to merchandise which has already been imported and has not been release by CBP custody before March 29, 2021.

Forced Labor is a Priority Trade Issue for CBP. Importers should be working through their supply chains to ensure their products are not being produced under Forced Labor conditions and review available resources.
