AB5 Protests at Port of Los Angeles and Long Beach

Dear Valued Customer,

We would like to inform you of port driver protests in Los Angeles and Long Beach that started on July 13th over the Supreme Court's AB5 ruling and will continue until further notice. On Monday July 18th, Oakland port drivers are planning to join the protest in support of their fellow drivers in Southern California. Their protest is scheduled to last until Wednesday July 20th, 2022.

The Owner Operators and Independent Contractors at the ports that are affected by AB5 are protesting the recent Supreme Court decision to deny the California Trucking Association's attempt to get trucking companies excluded from the law.

The protest is currently affecting services to and from LA/LB Terminals and operations are very slow. Please be aware of delays.

With your cargo planning in mind, we would like to highlight a few possible scenarios:

- We expect that operational processes may be strongly affected
- Truck deliveries might only be possible to a limited extent
- There might be an impact on the traffic situation around the port
- (Temporary) Storage charges may occur

We continue to monitor the situation and appreciate your patience and understanding during these challenging times.
