Certain COVID-19 Section 301 Exclusions Extended to May 2022

Dear Valued Customer,

The Office of the United States Trade Representative (USTR) announced that Section 301 exclusions for certain goods used to treat COVID-19 from China will be extended until May 31, 2022.

USTR will provide a transitional period for all COVID-19 product related exclusions that will be provisionally extended until November 30, 2021. Effective December 1, 2021, only 81 exclusions will be extended for another six months and will require the new heading 9903.88.66 to be declared.
