## Census Proposes New Country of Origin AES Filing Requirements

Dear Valued Customer,

On December 14, 2021, U.S. Census communicated that they are proposing a new country of origin data element requirement in the Automated Export System (AES) and has opened up a comment period for all interested parties to respond. Specifically, Census is proposing to add a “conditional” data element, (country of origin), when foreign origin is selected in the “Foreign/Domestic Origin Indicator” field in AES. If the rule is adopted, U.S. exporters of foreign-produced commodities would be required to declare the specific country of origin for their item(s) via this data element in AES. This is a marked departure from the current requirement to only declare if an item is Domestic (D) or Foreign (F) produced in AES.

Census believes any updates/enhancements to computer and software systems should be able to be implemented in a 12 to 18 month period when/if the final rule is implemented. The proposed rule lists several questions for exporters to consider, including, but not limited to, timeframe to amend/update software and systems to adjust to the new requirements as well as any new business practices a company would need to implement to comply with the proposed requirement.
